

# **HAMPTON COUNTRY CLUB RULES AND BY-LAWS**

## **1. MEMBERSHIP IN THE HAMPTON COUNTRY CLUB SHALL BE DIVIDED INTO CLASSES AS FOLLOWS:**

**FULL FAMILY MEMBERSHIP:** More than one golfing/social member in the same household, with the second member (or more) being either a spouse, significant other, child 17 or under, or college student up to age 23. Eligible to purchase stock in the 1st to 4th year of membership, stock purchase will be required at the end of the fourth year.

**FULL SINGLE/FAMILY SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP:** One golfing member in the household, with the second member (or more) being either a spouse, significant other, child 17 or under, or college student up to age 23, who is participating on a social level only, and is not eligible to participate in golf unless green fees are paid. Social guests are limited to county/in county visiting rules. Eligible to purchase stock in the 1st to 4th year of membership, stock purchase will be required at the end of the fourth year.

**FULL SINGLE MEMBERSHIP:** One golfing/social member in a household, with no other individual eligible to participate in club activities, with no spouse, significant other, child 17 or under, or college student up to age 23 eligible to participate in golf unless green fees are paid. Social guests limited to county/in-county visiting rules. Eligible to purchase stock in the 1st to 4th year of membership, stock purchase will be required at the end of the fourth year.

**HONORARY MEMBERSHIP:** In the event that a stockholder in good standing should become deceased, the Board of Governors may upon request, and by unanimous vote, exchange and grant an honorary membership for the share of stock of the said deceased member; said Honorary membership, if granted, to be in lieu of the cash consideration referred to in Article VII of the Articles of Incorporation.

**CORPORATE SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP:** Are available to bona fide businesses and include the same privileges as social members for an unlimited number of designees of the business. Club to be provided a list of designees.

**JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP:** Shall be single people, ages 18 to 23, out of high school, and not eligible to play under a parents' membership. Junior members are not allowed voting privileges.

**YOUTH MEMBERSHIP:** Shall be those persons, ages 12 to 18 inclusive,

whose parents or guardians are not members of the Hampton Country Club. After graduation from high school, a person will qualify for Junior membership through that golf season. Youth members are not allowed to participate in Thursday Men's Stags. Any HCC Board member may temporarily approve a junior member until the next board meeting.

**SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP:** Shall be members who use the clubhouse only, own no stock, have no voting privileges, can have no member or guest golf privileges.

**OUT-OF-STATE MEMBERSHIP:** Shall be members who have golf and clubhouse privileges and can play in club tournaments, the member cannot have a dwelling in Iowa and cannot own stock or have voting privileges.

**OUT-OF-COUNTY MEMBERSHIP:** Shall be members who have golf and clubhouse privileges and can play in club tournaments, the member cannot have a dwelling within 50 miles of Franklin County and cannot own stock or have voting privileges.

**COLLEGE MEMBERSHIP:** Shall be members who have golf and clubhouse privileges, out of high school, are attending college and are not eligible to play under a parents' membership. College members are not allowed voting privileges. College members may not play golf prior to 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday and Thursdays.

**CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP:** Shall be available to corporations with 5 or more memberships. Please check with the club manager regarding rules and regulations.
